Development-stage company #7024 provides a visual prosthetic device intended to improve the vision and quality of life for the over 1.6 million individuals suffering from advanced AMD, the leading cause of permanent visual impairment and blindness in the United States. The company expects to receive FDA approval for its technology in late 2009 after receiving a recommendation for approval from the FDA Ophthalmic Devices Advisory Panel. In the meantime, the company is currently engaged in a Phase II/III multi-center trial designed to establish safety and efficacy of its device in the treatment of patients with AMD or Stargardt's disease in both eyes.
